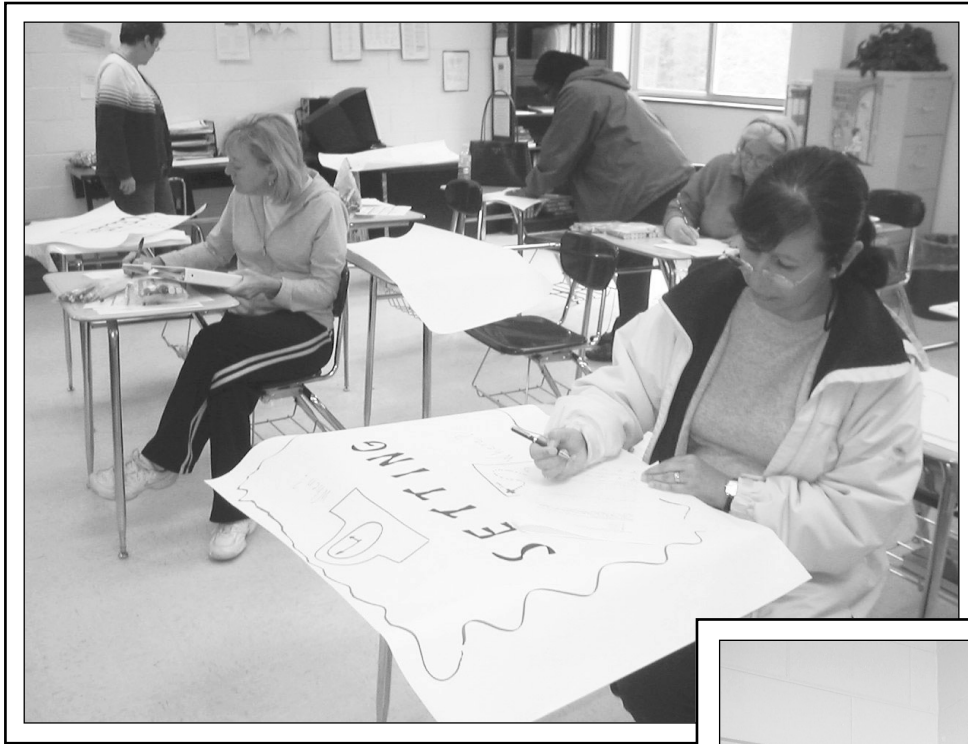


CONTENT POSTERS

Get Our Content on the Walls!



Content that everyone must learn should be displayed on posters so that everyone can see it clearly. Content posters should also be arranged in a way that “tells a story” or follows a logical pattern. In other words, group posters to enhance learning rather than random placement which will distract students. This takes a bit of advance planning because learners will be confused if posters are rearranged. If students develop single posters for you, be sure to have them follow the criteria for effective posters.

Another effective option is to have students develop small individual posters for important concepts. In this case, group them under a large heading and forego the rule about being large enough to see from a distance. They will remember the posters they made. The smaller versions can later be placed in knowledge folders to make room for other posters.
