

Self-Directed Learner's License Criteria

It is the student's responsibility to apply for a self-directed license. The license will be revoked immediately if any criteria are not subsequently followed. Self—Directed Licenses can only be used for those exemptions and alternative Okayed by the teacher.

Attendance	The student is rarely absent or takes personal responsibility to make up all missed work in a timely manner when absent (even if due to a field trip/excused activity).
Group/Partner Participation	The student can always or almost always be counted on to stay on task when directed to complete an activity with a partner or group.
Home Fun	The student completes almost all work on time and does not just copy work from solutions or answers.
Technology Use	The student only uses computers, tablets, phones, etc. for appropriate classroom use as directed by the teacher.
Assessment Mastery	The student strives diligently to master all objectives with correctives and retesting on forms B and/or C
Note Taking/Response Journal	The student always or almost always records notes (t-chart, definitions, responses to questions, etc) in his/her response journal or notebook.
Tardies	The student is never tardy or only on very rare occasion with a reasonable reason.
Double-Checking	The student always or almost always double-checks work with appropriate support provided.
Warm-Up & other Class work	The student always or almost always begins & works diligently on warm-up and other class work.
Responsible Behavior	The Student never abuses pass or self-directed license privileges and never asks for a pass if not needed for school appropriate reasons. The student always acts responsibly in class and throughout school. The student takes advantage of help opportunities whenever needed for keeping up and performing excellently.
